

1. The charts show how the spending habit of the Americans changed over a period of 30 years. Summarize the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant

The assigned couple of pie charts provide the information about spending habits of Americans, which changed over the course of 30 years between 1966 and 1996.

As per 1966 year is concerned people of America spent big chunk of money on food items and all, registered at 44% considerably whereas spending on computers amounted marginal at 1%. However, People of America seemed less interested in making expenditures on books, restaurants, petrol and furniture, as it averaged around 6% to 10% comparatively.

After the course of thirty years, although the expenditures on books, furniture, petrol and food deduced by the Americans but the decline on spending on food was dramatic, witnessed to be 30%. By contrast, sum of money consumed on restaurants and cars doubled almost than previous year, which was recorded at 14% and 45%.

In total, it can be said that habit to spend money reversed among American citizens over the time span from food to car.
